THE RURAL MUNICIPALITY OF TACHE

BY-LAW NO. 32-97

Being a By-law of The Rural Municipality of Taché to regulate the use of Firearms and Fireworks in parts of the Municipality.

WHEREAS Part (5) Division (1) of the Municipal Act provides as follows:

140(1) A Council may act only by Resolution or By-law, and;

WHEREAS Part (7) Division (2) of The Municipal Act provides as follows:

232(2) A Council may in a By-law passed under this Division:
a) Regulate or Prohibit;
e) Subject to the regulations, provide a system of licenses, permits or approvals including:
(iii) Prohibiting a Development, Activity, Industry, Business or thing until a License, Permit or approval is granted.

NOW THEREFORE, The Rural Municipality of Taché in Council duly assembled enact as follows:

- THAT the use and firing of rifles, guns, revolvers, pistols, pellet guns and other firearms and weapons, be and is hereby prohibited in:
 All lands owned by and situated within the boundaries of The Rural Municipality of Taché.
- 2. THAT every permit issued under this By-law shall be made out in duplicate and be signed by the C.A.O. who is hereby authorized to issue such permit and sign same on behalf of the Municipality, one copy will be delivered to the applicant who shall have same on his person when acting upon it.
- **3. THAT** the fee for each permit shall be the sum of **\$5.00**, and unless they are expressly granted for a shorter period, shall be operative for the calendar year current at the time of issue, to expire on December 31st next succeeding the date of issue. All such permits to be non-transferable and to be considered a personal permit.
- 4. THAT the C.A.O. is hereby authorized to issue permits where same are to be used for the sole purpose of destroying predatory or mischievous animals.
- 5. THAT any person who contravenes, or refuses, omits, neglects or fails to obey or observe any provision of this By-law is guilty of an offense and is liable on summary conviction to a fine not exceeding **One Hundred (\$100.00) Dollars**, or to imprisonment for a term not exceeding one month, or to both such a fine and such an imprisonment.
- 6. THAT By-law No. 1326 be repealed.
